Debra Harkiewicz is Director of Civil Engineering, 502nd Air Base Wing, Fort Sam Houston, Texas. She is responsible for the oversight and integration of civil engineering activities for Joint Base San Antonio which includes Randolph and Lackland Air Force bases and the Army's Fort Sam Houston and Camp Bullis. The 502nd ABW consolidates 49 installation management functions, 42% of which are related to civil engineering management of a \$10.9 billion plant replacement value encompassing over 50,000 acres across the 502nd ABW. The 502nd ABW also supports in excess of \$4.5 billion in directed Base Closure and Realignment construction activities and other major projects. Ms Harkiewicz has had more than 20 years experience in civil engineering technical and leadership positions with assignments at Air Force installation and headquarters levels, including relevant experience in management of military construction programs, facility program develop and Chief of housing privatization at Lackland Air Force Base. She also held positions at HQ Air Education and Training Command (AETC) where she was responsible for management of facility programming and budgeting and environmental analysis for 13 bases across AETC. She has also served in HQ leadership roles as Chief of Asset Management Strategies, Balanced Scorecard, CE Strategic planning and Air Force Lean, Six-sigma initiatives.

Ms Harkiewicz has a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Architecture from the University of Texas at San Antonio. She also has a Master's Degree in Military Science from Air University, Alabama. She has completed Air Command and Staff College and Air War College and has attended leadership courses such as Base Civil Engineering Squadrons Commanders Course and Emergency Incident Managers Course at the Air Force Institute of Technology located at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio. She has also participated in the Alamo Federal Executive Board Leadership Development program and held a multi-year position as a trustee on the Lackland Independent School Board. Ms Harkiewicz has been awarded the Air Force Meritorious Civilian Service Medal, Exemplary Civilian Service Medal, and is a multiple-time recipient of the Air Education and Training Command Major General William D Gilbert Award.
