Bobby Lynn supervises and administers the Army Energy Program at Fort Hood, reducing the Army's utility cost an average of \$40 million/year. He coordinates and develops engineering projects. Since 1991, Fort Hood has realized savings of over \$1 million a year. He serves as the Utilities Sales Officer to resell utilities services to appropriate Federal and non-federal entities located on the installation. He Began work at Fort Hood, Texas (1983) as an Electrical Engineer Intern (GS-07) and was rapidly promoted upward to GS-11. He obtained GS-12 promotion (1988) and assumed the position of Chief, Energy Mgmt Office, Fort Hood, Texas. He was promoted to GS-13 Supervisory Electrical Engineer, Chief, Energy Management Branch, in January 2011.
