ANTHONY MARTINEZ

Mr. Anthony Martinez is the current Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) Energy and Environmental Program Manager. Mr. Martinez is a 1980 graduate of Trinity University with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. Mr. Martinez is a Registered Texas Professional Engineer. In 1981 Mr. Martinez became a Mechanical Engineer at Kelly AFB and was named Air Logistics Center Senior Engineer of the Year in 1994. He went to Randolph AFB in Jul of 2000 as an Environmental Engineer and was Environmental Chief before moving to the Energy Office in August of 2008. In 2008 was part of a team that was awarded the Presidential FEMP award for energy management. At Randolph Mr. Martinez was recognized for reenergizing their Energy program which received over \$15M of funding for Projects in the 2009 and 2010. Mr. Martinez was selected to lead the Joint Base effort in Environmental and Energy. Through his leadership JBSA and Defense Transformation Institute (DTI) signed an Energy Memorandum of Understanding establishing the JBSA/DTI Innovation Center. Mr. Martinez is spearheading a team working on a solar project for JBSA and is partnering with the Office of Secretary of Defense in creating a Strategic Energy Management Plan for JBSA that will be used as a model of Joint Bases for all DOD.
